PROJECT BACKGROUND

Whoville is a small town located at the base of Mount Crumpit. This idyllic community faced an unprecedented crisis when the infamous Grinch attempted to steal Christmas.

In the wake of this incident, McConnell was appointed to face the daunting task of restoring not only its physical structures but also its sense of community.

PROJECT DELIVERY

The team faced a monumental challenge restoring Whoville in time for Christmas, but their expertise and the community's collaboration turned the daunting project into a heartwarming success. The team began with an assessment of the structural damage, prioritising repairs that would ensure safety and functionality for the townsfolk.

First, the site team repaired damaged chimneys and rooftops, which bore the brunt of the Grinch's entry and exit methods. Using reinforced brick and mortar, the contractor ensured these structures could withstand future winters. Windows and broken doors were replaced with new, energy-efficient materials, preserving Whoville's whimsical architecture while enhancing durability.

In Whoville Square, the iconic Christmas tree plaza was a focal point of restoration. The team reinstalled a secure base for the tree and replaced damaged ornaments with durable, handcrafted designs. The electrical grid powering the town's festive lights also required attention. Electricians upgraded the system to handle the load of holiday displays more reliably.

Inside homes, the team addressed damage to interiors, such as scratched floors, torn upholstery, and collapsed ceilings. Plumbers repaired burst pipes caused by heavy hauling through snowy conditions, ensuring homes were warm and water-tight. Public spaces, including Whoville's community hall, underwent refurbishments to prepare for the upcoming "Restoration Festival."
